BOTTLE BAY RECREATIONAL WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING

September 10, 2024

The Bottle Bay Recreational Water and Sewer District (BBRWSD) Regular Board meeting held by Zoom, was called to order at 4:01 p.m. by Bill Berg, after verifying the required quorum. Board members present were: Bill Berg, Rob Behrens, Jon Davis, Steve Shearer and Julie Houske. Also in attendance were Bob Hansen and Brent Binnal (WSM) and RuthAnn Zigler, Recording Secretary. Guest in attendance: Chris Wyckoff.

CONSENT AGENDA

Steve Shearer made a motion to approve the August 20, 2024 Regular Board meeting minutes as presented. Jon Davis seconded and the motion carried.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Chris Wyckoff comments asked for a clarification on the Boards process once his application is submitted and the deposit required.

REPORTS

Treasurers Report

<u>Status of checking accounts and accounts in Local Government Investment Pool</u>: The Mt. West Bank (2094) account balance is \$63,428.49; Mt. West Bank (8384) account balance is \$11,678.36. Balances for LGIP1 and LGIP2 accounts were not available at time of meeting.

Moving to different bank; there will be three options at next meeting.

Operations Report (August)

We are in really great shape and are operating where we need to be operating where we should be at year end with our lagoons being full or not full.

Collections Report (August)

<u>Status report on capital and other construction projects:</u> Oldest (1972 to 1990) main-line connections have been installed with 84 remaining; 48 newer main-line connections to be installed; and seven (7) out of ten pump controls have been upgraded.

Permit & Compliance Matters

Nelson, hookup #026 – There is sufficient septic tank capacity; now charging for ADU.

Island Vista, hookup #038 – Application and deposit has been received.

Wyckoff, hookup #040 – Application was submitted. Discussed if a deposit waiver would be allowed due to the nature of the work. Chris will send the Board a written request for their review and decision.

Petersen, hook #098 – Application and deposit has been received, permit has been approved and construction has started.

Ouhi, hookup #101 – Application and deposit has been received, permit has been approved. Started construction. They have exposed the lateral line and have placed a great deal weighted spoils on the line which is causing a possible breakage in the line.

Hale, hookup #112 – Application has been received.

Olson, hookup #152 – Application and deposit has been received. Construction has started.

Simchuk, hookup #171 – Application and deposit has been received, permit has been approved.

Mack, hookup #175 – Application and deposit has been received. Adding bathroom to bunkhouse that has been approved.

Oakley, hookup #211 – Application and deposit has been received, permit has been approved, construction has started.

Audubon, LLC, hookup #309 – Application and deposit has been received. A letter was sent to owner about removing the spoils and they have until the end of August to remove to avoid a fine being assessed. As of this date, there has been no response. A pile of gravel was dumped on the District's easement, trespassing on both sides of neighboring property; not in compliance, and property is up for sale. Pictures will be sent to the District's attorney for her advice. The Board agreed that we will notify the listing real estate agent to make them aware of the issues.

Atteberry, hookup #321 – Application and deposit has been received, permit has been approved, construction has started and the inspection is underway.

General Administrative Matters

<u>Capital Improvement Plan</u>: In July of 2022 the Board approved a two-part capital improvement plan; part one was that we were going to use capital depreciation amount (approximately \$50,000/year) and the second part is that the steel septic tanks would be replaced and provide nine (9) new pump control units per year. The capital plan needs to be amended no later then the November 2024 meeting to clarify the plan over the next five (5) years. The Board was asked to think about how much to increase the capital improvement plan dollar amount.

<u>Levy:</u> Bill explained that the District can levy \$35,730 for our property tax levy that we get from everybody in the District. In the 2024 budget, we budgeted \$34,128. You can't tax more then what is put in the budget and we don't want to lose the money so we have to reserve \$1,601.00.

Rob Behrens made a motion to authorize a reserve amount of \$1,601.00 from this year's tax levy for future years. Julie_Houske seconded and the motion carried.

Next meeting: The next meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, October 15, 2024 at 4:00 p.m. by zoom.

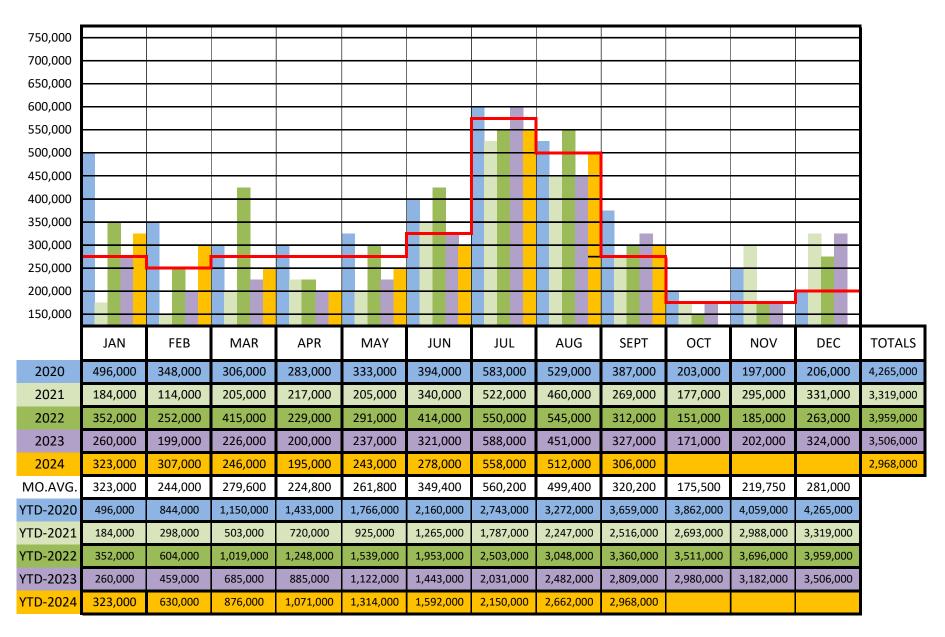

That does add a wrinkle. I chained the title through the Bonner County records and found the attached draft express easement. Unfortunately, the legal description is incomplete in that it is missing "Block 2" from the legal description. However, under Idaho law, it could be argued it is adequate to create an express easement. To bind Audubon to the express easement, it would be the District's burden to show Audubon was not a bona fide purchaser. To be bona fide, Audubon had to take without inquiry notice of the express easement. . I suspect this easement showed on Audubon's title report if they pulled one.

If a court is not persuaded an express easement exists, then there is still a prescriptive easement theory to pursue. This document establishes the pipeline was installed *circa* 1995. This easement establishes that Audubon's predecessor, the Wriggles, had personal knowledge of the placement of the pipeline since they played a role in the location. The document in subpart (1) specifically notes the sewer line was located on the lot in a location to which location the Wiggles agreed. The District must prove by clear and convincing evidence that the easement was

- 1. Open and notorious given the language of the draft easement, this element is established;
- 2. Continuous and uninterrupted since the line was installed and remains, this element is established;
- 3. Adverse and under a claim of right even if defective, the easement shows the District was claiming an easement from the date of execution of the easement;
- 4. With the actual or imputed knowledge of the owner of the servient tenement again, the easement demonstrat3es actual knowledge of the owner; and
- 5. For the prescriptive period since this use began before 2006, the 5 year statute applies and the District has met the prescriptive duration.

Given this background, the District has at a minimum a prescriptive easement, if not an express easement. The causes of action remain the same as I outlined previously. I suggest (if your professionals indicate the pipeline is a risk) that you send Audubon, LLC, a copy of the easement and emphasize that it is required to restore the easement. You can also indicate that the District is prepared to record a Notice to Title concerning the issue so future buyers are aware the easement needs restored. However, before the District takes such action, we should discuss slander of title and whether we can prevail at trial with the claim that the pipeline is at risk.

Once we are beyond this issue, the District should consider if it wishes to take steps to address the "Block 2" ambiguity created by the existing easement.

Bill:

In reviewing the Bel Tane plat (attached), I note of page 2 of the plat a 20' reserved easement for a sewer line within Block 2, the location of this lot. While it does not explicitly call out the District as the entity for whom the easement is reserved, it is a fair position to take that the easement is the District's easement.

Based upon that point of view, there is a cause of action for interference with easement (a form of trespass), nuisance and damages if the District restores the line. It would be the District's burden to establish that the spoils and grading interfere with the easement and pose a danger to the stability of the sewer line. You may want to have a geotechnical engineer or other professional review the site to determine if there is an interference with the easement

Please let me know if you have any follow-up questions regarding this matter.

Susan: we have a problem with a pile of gravel and now-abandoned road cut over our mainline. See pictures attached. The line runs across a lot in Bel Tane Acres. The lot is vacant and the owner was attempting to cut in a road. Now he's just put the lot up for sale. Our concern is that the hillside is unstable and the line itself is not of the highest quality. We're concerned that the weight of the gravel combined with instability caused by the half-ass road cut could rupture the line. I sent a letter to the land owner, see attached, demanding that he remove the gravel and recontour the hillside but he has not responded.

I stupidly assumed, until I looked this morning, that we in fact had an easement for the line across the guy's lot. But I can't find one in the records, although I'll follow-up with Will Valentine. I was hoping we could threaten injunctive relief to get the guy to recontour the hillside. What's your advice on this?

DRAFT EASEMENT AGREEMENT

GRANTORS:

LARRY K. WRIGGLE and _ husband and wife.

NANCY L. WRIGGLE,

GRANTEE:

THE BOTTLE BAY WATER AND SEWER DISTRICT, a political subdivision of the State of Idaho,

For valuable consideration, Grantors, hereinafter "Grantor", owner of the following described real property in Bonner County,

Lot 1, Beltane Acres, according to the Plat thereof, recorded in the records of Bonner County, Idaho.

"Block Two"

Do hereby grant to Bottle Bay Water and Sewer District a perpetual easement, right and privilege for the following purpose:

- (1) To install, lay and maintain on and in said property a sewer pipeline at the location which has been surveyed and engineered, which has been identified on the ground and to which we have agreed.
- (2) To enter upon said property from time to time for the purpose of installing, maintaining, replacing and repairing

Grantor covenants that he is the owner of the above described premises and has a good right to grant this easement. Grantor's title to the premises is free and clear of liens and encumbrances, except for those of record this date.

Grantor reserves the right to use the surface of the ground above the pipeline, except that Grantor shall erect no permanent improvements over said pipeline. During construction the Grantee's contractor may have a temporary easement of ten (10) feet on either side of the pipeline; however, when said pipeline is in place and the ditch covered, the easement shall lie five (5) feet on either side of the pipeline as hereinabove
